Art Exhibit Takes Project on the Road

Thunderbox Road, a traveling exhibit of 12 outhouses (Thunderboxes) showcasing the artistic talents of 12 of the top artists in the region, tours the Hill Country and San Antonio destinations preparing for the auction in May of 2009.

The project was created by Sand Creek Post & Beam of Texas and Cedar Eaters of Texas. Sand Creek sells barn kits based on historic turn-of-the-century designs. Their love of farm and ranch architecture, and their desire to highlight the artistic talents of Hill Country artists, inspired the project.

The Spring 2009 Thunderbox Road Tour includes the San Antonio Stock Show and Rodeo in February and

after the rodeo, the exhibit will be hosted by the new South African-themed Serengeti Resort, north of San Antonio near Bergheim. In mid-April, after their appearance at The Serengeti, Thunderbox Road moves to The Museum of Western Art in Kerrville.

The auction will be Saturday, May 9, 2009 at The Museum of Western Art's Pavilion, benefitting The PKU Medical Research Foundation and The Museum of Western Art's Teachers' Workshops.
